Hurry!!!!

Seniors who are in Hospitals or Skilled Nursing Facilities and need a place to stay may qualify for the Assisted Living Waiver Program (ALWP). This program allows for a senior to move into an Assisted Living Facility where 24-hour non-medical care will be provided and subsidized by the State of California.

They will receive:

- Lodging
- Three nutritious meals daily, plus mid-day and evening nourishments
- Fresh linens, daily cleaning of resident's rooms
- Personal laundry
- 24-Hour supervision and assistance with personal care
- Prescribed medication supervision
- Assistance with obtaining medical and dental care
- Assistance in obtaining emergency health care
- Regular observation of resident's mental and physical condition
- Daily living activities, as well as training in daily living skills
- Assistance with bathing, dressing, grooming, hygiene, and feeding
- Planned indoor and outdoor activities will provide opportunities for socialization, use of leisure time, independent functioning, and physical development, and conditioning
- Transportation to resident's medical and dental appointments
- Transportation to facility planned activities by private care
- Complete security system with a smoke alarm, emergency lighting, earthquake, and survival supplies
- Utilities such as cable TV, DVD, stereo, and more

We don't have to wait for 60 days for any new ALW referral. We can make an application on any resident that has no share and on Medi-Cal. Once we receive everything, we can submit the application to the State. Please note that the applicant cannot go home otherwise they will go onto a community waitlist of up to two years currently.

The applicant may go into an RCFE/ALF care setting.

Please look below to find a list of what is needed. Some information will be provided by you and some information by the Hospital or Skilled Nursing Facility. Please inform the facility that you are working with us to facilitate the paperwork for enrollment into the ALWP. The expiration is not certain, therefore, we recommend whoever is in need should contact us as soon as possible. At any time, if you have any questions, please call or email us.

List of forms needed:

- Admission Face Sheet from a skilled nursing facility
- Assessment tool from the skilled nursing facility (also provided via email)
- Medication list from a skilled nursing facility
- Physicians 602 report from the skilled nursing facility (also provided via email) signed by the MD
- History and physical copy from the skilled nursing facility. (preferably the one from the hospital; they should have a copy of this)
- Amenity Form signed by member or person named on Advance Health Care Directive
- Freedom of choice signed by member or person named on Advance Health Care Directive
- Room and Board Acknowledgment signed by member or person named on Advance Health Care Directive
- ISP-Last Page (no dates anywhere only sign at the bottom) signed by member or person named on Advance Health Care Directive.
